Universal Fall Screening (easyCBM) Grades K-5	August 15 – 26, 2016	LSS – The purpose of the universal screening is to provide a data snapshot of a student’s current performance at three points during the school year and, in some cases, progress throughout the school year, in a variety of academic areas.	Screening results are not distributed outside the school. Results are not used for grades
Universal Winter Screening (easyCBM) Grades K-5	January 17 – 31, 2017	LSS – See Universal Fall Screening (in August) for a description of this assessment.	See Universal Fall Screening (in August) for a description of how results from this assessment are made available.
ACCESS for ELs Grades K-5 (English language learner students only)	TBD – Typically in March and April, 2017	TDOE – The ACCESS for ELs assessment measures English Language proficiency levels with respect to the WIDA ELP Standards and is used as one criterion to determine when ELLs have attained the language proficiency needed to participate meaningfully in content area classrooms.	Scores and other information from this assessment are delivered to the schools for distribution in August. Results are not used for grades.
TCAP Alternate Assessment (MSAA) Grades 3-5 (ELA and math for select special education students only)	TBD – Typically April, 2017	These alternate assessments are for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities whom participation in the regular state assessment is inappropriate, even with the use of extensive accommodations.	Scores and other information from this assessment are delivered to the schools for distribution. Results are not used for grades.
TNReady, Summative Assessments Grades 3-5	April 18- April 28, 2017 See Detailed TN Ready Testing Calendar 3rd-5th Grade	TDOE – The TNReady Summative Assessments in ELA, math, and social studies are in two parts; with Part II consisting of a variety of student select response items.	Raw scores from the Part II assessments will be combined with those from Part I for a single final score. Students will receive quick scores for grading purposes in May, and complete proficiency reporting is expected in the fall.
Grade 2 Assessment	April 25 - May 5, 2017 See Detailed TN Ready Testing Calendar 2nd Grade	LSS – The purpose of the K-2 Assessment is to provide a snapshot of the student’s current performance level in ELA and math.	Scores and other information from this assessment are delivered to the schools for distribution. Results are not used for grades.
Universal Spring Screening (easy CBM) Grades K – 5	TBD – Typically in May, 2017	LSS - See Universal Fall Screening (in August) for a description of this assessment.	Screening results are not distributed outside the school. Results are not used for grades
